A Plan For Our Future

Tasmania *Together* is a plan developed by Tasmanians for our community. It outlines what we want for ourselves, our children, and our State by the year 2020. It sets the goals that we are aiming for – as well as ways to measure our progress – so we can see what we’ve achieved and what still needs to be done.

As a community plan, Tasmania *Together* gives the community a say in how it will change over time. It is reviewed every five years, so that it remains current and reflects changing priorities in the Tasmanian community. The plan has one vision, 12 goals and over 140 benchmarks to monitor our progress – and it’s built into government decision-making. ‘Headline indicators’ will summarise our progress towards each goal.

Our Goals

1. A reasonable lifestyle and standard of living for all Tasmanians.
2. Confident, friendly and safe communities.
3. High quality education and training for lifelong learning and a skilled workforce.
4. Active, healthy Tasmanians with access to quality and affordable health care services.
5. Vibrant, inclusive and growing communities where people feel valued and connected.
6. Dynamic, creative and internationally recognised arts community and culture.
7. Acknowledgement of the right of Aboriginal people to own and preserve their culture, and share with non-Aboriginal people the richness and value of that culture.
8. Open and accountable government that listens and plans for a shared future.
9. Increased work opportunities for all Tasmanians.
10. Thriving and innovative industries driven by a high level of business confidence.
11. Built and natural heritage that is valued and protected.
12. Sustainable management of our natural resources.

What’s It All About?

Tasmania *Together* is about achieving the community’s vision for a better Tasmania. It’s about providing opportunities, creating prosperity and improving our quality of life and wellbeing.

It’s also about making Tasmania a great place to be – by building strong, inclusive communities with a dynamic, creative culture.

It’s about looking after our future by valuing and protecting our environment and using our resources sustainably.

And it’s about working together – finding new ways to move forward and achieve the community’s vision for our State’s future.

The Progress Board

The Tasmania *Together* Progress Board is an independent statutory authority responsible for monitoring and promoting the work of Tasmania *Together*. The Board’s nine members are drawn from a variety of backgrounds to best represent the Tasmanian community.

Every two years, the Progress Board reports on our progress towards achieving the benchmarks, and every five years the Board consults widely with the community and conducts a major review.

The Board works to encourage community involvement in the achievement of the goals and benchmarks. It has developed partnerships with a range of organisations that are working on benchmark issues in the business, community and local government sectors.
